Deaths:

MILES WILLIAMS

Funeral services for Miles Williams held at Jones Cemetery Sunday by Rev. L.P.V. Williams of Morehead and the Odd Fellows' Lodge of this place. He was killed in

February in the sawmill of S.B. Reese near here. Left a wife, daughter and son. Farmers.

Note: There is a difference in the date on the stone (1904) and the newspaper obituary date (1903).

Additional information on Miles Williams:

Owingsville Outlook, 12 Mar 1903

Feb. 27, 1903, Miles Williams, aged about 40. He was an engineer in Reese's mill near Farmers and in fixing a belt, was caught in the machinery and had both legs broken and was injured internally from which he died the following day. Left a wife and four children. Burial by the Oddfellows at Jones' graveyard. Salt Lick.
