Florence Marie Myers left Salt Lick, KY in the mid 1920's to be with her brothers, Elbert Arthur (Turk) Myers and Willie Tilford (Poll) Myers, who lived in Pittsburgh, PA. During this stay, while playing bridge at a card party, she met R. B. Omohundro who was the manager of an A&P grocery store in Pittsburgh. This meeting led to a marriage on June 23, 1927, and the birth of twin sons in 1929. After leaving Pittsburgh, there was a brief stay in Ashland, VA. The family then moved to Salt Lick, KY in 1933 and R. B. and Marie remained there except for a couple of years in the 1940's during World War II that were spent in Baltimore, MD working at the Glenn L. Martin Defense Plant where the B-26 bombers were built.
