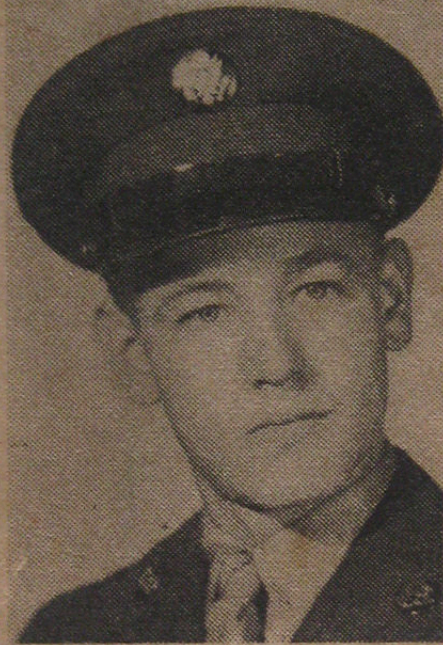


W. Morehead Soldier Killed In Korea

Henry Beasley Meets
Death In Korea; Only
Brother Missing

A Morehead soldier, Pvt. Henry E. Beasley, was killed in action in Korea, October 13, the war department officially announced today.

The war department has also announced that his brother, Wilbur Beasley, has been missing in action since July 25.

They are the only sons of Mrs. Nora Beasley Gilliam who lives in West Morehead.

The announcement did not state in what engagement or what part of Korea Beasley met his death. He entered the armed forces October 18, 1948 and received his basic training at Camp Breckinridge, Ky. He left the states February 14, 1949 and was stationed at Camp Drew, Japan until his unit moved to Korea at the outbreak of hostilities. Prior to his enlistment he attended the public schools in Morehead.

Mrs. Beasley said she had been notified by telegram of her son's death. She said she had also received notice that her other son was missing in action as of July 25 and feared that he, too, is dead.
